



What Information Do I Need When I Fill Out the FAFSA

Here's a checklist!

You should have the following information and documents with you as you fill out the 2015-16 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA):

- Student's Social Security number
- Parent(s)' Social Security number(s) *if, per FAFSA, student is dependent*
- Student's driver's license number if student has one
- Student's Alien Registration Number if student is not a U.S. citizen
- 2014 tax information (*if required to file*) for student (*and spouse, if married*) and parent(s) if, per FAFSA, student is dependent
 - ***To complete and submit the 2015-16 FAFSA in January, use estimated tax information (i.e. 2013 tax return, 2014 W-2 information, or last paystub)***
- Records of untaxed income, such as child support received and veterans noneducation benefits, for student and parent(s) if, per FAFSA, student is dependent
- Information on checking and savings account balances; investments; and business and farm assets for student and parent(s) if, per FAFSA, student is dependent
- Student's Federal Student Aid PIN (*may be obtained during application*)
- Parent's Federal Student Aid PIN if, per FAFSA, student is dependent (*may be obtained during application*)
